The origins of the Folkestone Art Society lie in a group of about 30 people from Folkestone and Hythe meeting together, in 1928, to further their interest in arts and crafts. From those humble beginnings the Society has grown to become a vibrant community of over 200 members.

As its name suggests, the Society is still firmly rooted in Folkestone, a town with a growing reputation nationally and internationally, as a centre for the creative arts.

With many eminent artists as past members, the Society today is an inclusive charitable incorporated organisation bringing together both practicing artists and those with a commitment to the visual and creative arts.

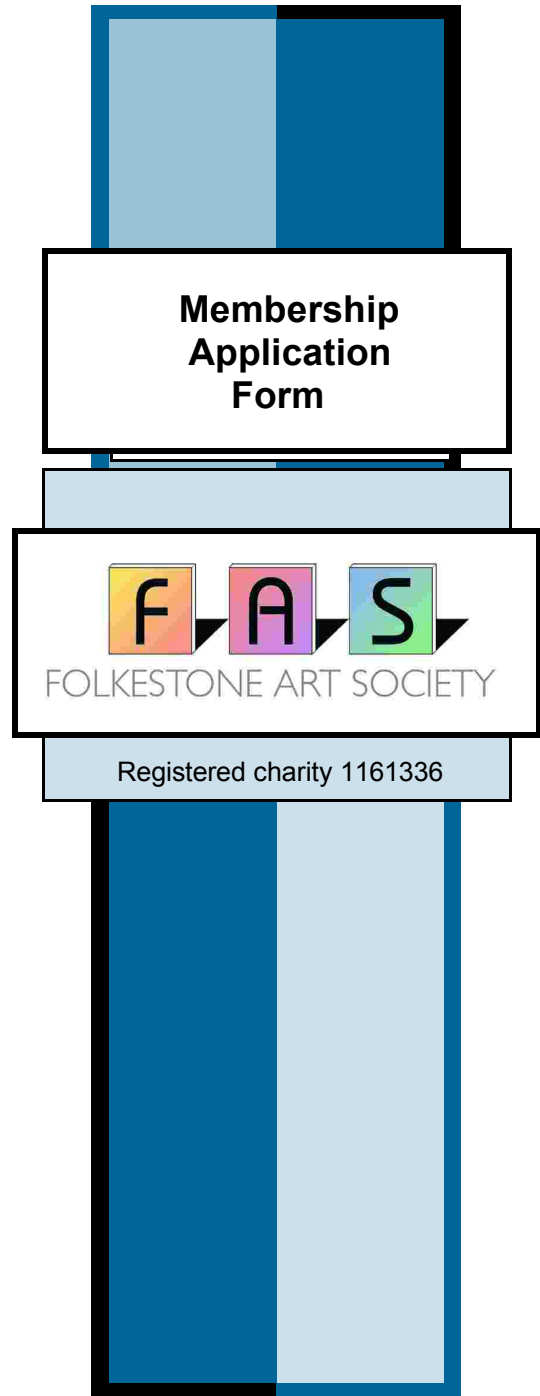

Founded in 1928, the Folkestone Art Society (FAS) is a not-for-profit charitable incorporated organisation (registered charity no. 1161336) run by its members through an elected executive committee.

Its purpose is to promote knowledge and appreciation of the visual arts, for the public benefit, through exhibitions, demonstrations and workshops. The FAS encourages high standards in the visual arts and the sharing of expertise and knowledge, amongst its members and more widely.

Embracing a range of art forms, including painting, pastels, drawing, sculpture, etching and ceramics, the FAS holds a number of public exhibitions each year at which members can showcase and sell their artworks. FAS exhibitions are amongst the largest in Kent with approximately 300 works of art on view. It also publishes an annual Art Review incorporating artwork by members.
